- Built using a raspberry pi, microphones and speakers.
- Coded in python using the google assistant API.

PORTABLE INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARD – A DEVICE THAT RECOGNISES A GIVEN OBJECT AS A PEN AND THE TRACKS ITS MOVEMENT THROUGH 2D SPACE AND MAPS THIS ONTO THE WALL BEHIND

- Connected a raspberry pi to a camera module and a projector. Coded in python, using OpenCV software.
- Eliminates the need for a fixed whiteboard set up as this device can be set up anywhere using anything as a controller.
